

Full-Time Virtual Option

- ❑ Sayre Schools offers a full-time virtual option for schooling on a case-by-case basis. This option is for an individual student and is subject to approval by Sayre Schools Administration. An appeal process for any student who is denied is available.
 - The virtual option for schooling will be for core subjects (English/Reading, Math, Social Studies, & Science) and other state requirements. Educational delivery will be through an online digital method, using the vendor Edgenuity. The student should be able to work through the program independently; however, a parent will need to monitor educational progress and assist as needed. A teacher will be assigned as a contact to help the student.
 - Students choosing the virtual option will not participate in school-sponsored extracurricular activities.
 - If this option is selected, the student and parent must commit to a full semester of the virtual program. This will keep the student on pace despite a differing order of curriculum than what may occur in the traditional classroom. Students will have a one-week virtual trial period before being locked in for the semester.
 - Students may check-out a device from the school for use during virtual learning. The student will be responsible for returning the device in working condition, or they will be responsible for the damage.
 - The virtual option must be deemed educationally appropriate by school personnel. If a student severely struggles in processing written material, for example, reading passages and learning independent of the classroom may not be appropriate.
